NIV BIBLE

All students in grades 2-12 will use a Bible at school; digital editions will not be used. All students receive a Bible from their 2nd grade teachers or upon enrollment. Students may choose to use this each year or purchase a Bible (NIV) of their choice. A Bible can be purchased in the office for \$8.50.

GYM SHOES

Non-marking gym shoes are required for PE in the gym (Kindergarten-6th/MS and HS if enrolled in PE). *These shoes will be kept at school FOR GYM USE ONLY. Keep your receipt in case the PE teacher determines your child's shoes do not meet the criteria. Velcro closure if your child is unable to tie his/her own shoes.*
