

# Crosspoint Christian School Supply List

2021-2022

- SUPPLY FEE**            \$35 per student (All Grades). *This fee will cover consumable classroom supplies.*
- LOCK FEE**             \$4 (Grades 6-12). *School-issued locks for lockers will be required.*
- NIV BIBLE**            \$8.50 for a new NIV Bible, if needed. *Students receive an NIV Bible from school in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade or upon enrollment. Additional Bibles can be purchased. Personal NIV Bibles can also be used.*
- GYM SHOES**         Non-marking gym shoes are required for PE in the gym (Preschool-5<sup>th</sup>/MS and HS if enrolled in PE). *These shoes will be kept at school for gym use only. KEEP YOUR RECEIPT in case the PE teacher determines that your child's shoes do not meet the criteria. Velcro closure if your child is unable to tie his/her own shoes.*

- 1-2 containers of Clorox or Lysol wipes
