

DRESS CODE

Standard School Uniform:

- Polo Shirt: Gray, navy, teal OR white.
- Pants: Chino style in black, navy or khaki. Denim pants can be in black or tan.
- Crosspoint Letterman Jacket
- Sweatshirts, Quarter Zip Activewear Pullover, Vest: Gray, navy, teal OR white. CCS logo only, no logo at all or small logo (approx. 1"-3"). School colored t-shirt is allowed under sweatshirt/quarter zip pullover.

BOYS:

• **Shorts:** Golf or chino style in black, navy, or khaki.

Length: All shorts, skirts, dresses and jumpers are required to be mid-thigh.

Mid-thigh is half-way between the top of the inseam and top of knee.

GIRLS:

- Capris, Chino Shorts, and Skirts: Black, navy, or khaki.
- Dresses and Jumpers: Navy, and Khaki.
 Polo must be worn under jumper. Bike shorts underneath are encouraged
- Leggings (K-12): Solid color (black or navy) leggings or tights may be worn under dresses and skirts.
- Preschool ONLY are allowed to wear leggings as pants in approved colors.

Maritor Wear Day (Friday & Rield III)

-Jeans (NO HOLES).

-OSAA sport event Crosspoint participated in.

-Any component of the regular dress code

-Any top with a Crosspoint logo on it.

DRESS CODE DETAILS

POLICY 6.35 DRESS CODE

Crosspoint Christian School is a uniform school for the following reasons:

- Students are judged not by their clothes but by the quality of their character.
- Students in uniform generally perform better and have fewer behavioral problems.
- CCS strives for excellence in all areas of a student's life: academics, spiritual walk, sports and appearance.

DRESS CODE VIOLATION CONSEQUENCES

Students should be in appropriate attire whenever they enter the building on a school day.

- If student is out of compliance with the dress code, the issue will be addressed at the administrative level.
- Administration has the authority to make decisions on questionable appearance not specifically addressed within the dress code policy or pertaining to matters where questions of "appropriateness" arise.

Ask administration if you have questions, or concerns on specific items.



Items that promote tobacco, alcohol, drugs or lifestyles that conflict with the ideas and goals of CCS.

- ANY undergarments showing.
- Half-shirts, spaghetti straps, halter type tops or tight-fitting tank tops. When standing normally, shirts should extend at least to the top of pants.
- No Items that alter the CCS uniform.

- Heavy jewelry, baggy trousers, symbols, or colors.
- Bikini or speedo swimsuits.
- Sweatpants, yoga pants, and basketball shorts.
- Clothing with holes or rips.
- Hoods and Hats on inside school.

General Dress Rules: General dress rules apply while the student is on campus or other settings while students are under the authority of Crosspoint Christian School staff. This includes CCS activity groups or teams representing Crosspoint (class trips, athletic events, performances, etc.) General Dress Rule applies to "Free Dress Day"

Accessories

- Sunglasses are not permitted indoors without a doctor's note.
- Make-up must not be excessive or extreme.
- Belts and jewelry must not be excessive or extreme.
- Hair accessories must not be excessive or extreme.
 Ex: cat ear head bands.
- Body piercings must not be visible. Nose piercings and ear gauges are not allowed.
- Females may have pierced ears and only two earrings per ear.
- Tattoos must not be visible.

Shoes: For safety reasons, footwear must be always worn while on campus.

- Elementary students: No open-toe shoes or sandals.
- M.S/H.S students: Sandals are allowed.
- Wheeled shoes are not allowed.

Hair: must always be a natural hair color, neatly trimmed, well-groomed and kept out of the eyes. **Boys:** hair must be natural colored. Facial hair must be neatly trimmed and well-groomed.

Athletic Team Game Days: On game days only, athletic teams may choose to dress as a team, i.e., team jersey, dresses, shirt, and ties, etc. Students not dressing to match a team should be in school uniform.

College Wear: Seniors may dress in college wear or Senior gear on Mondays.
